- Illegal Fireworks: Any firework that flies into the air, explodes or behaves in an uncontrollable and unpredictable manner.
- If you are setting off fireworks at home, keep a supply of water close by as a precaution.
- Make sure your pet has identification and stays inside as much as possible.
- Be considerate of your veteran neighbors. Fireworks can resemble the explosions and blasts that some military veterans experienced while deployed. Any veterans in crisis or in need of help, please contact the Veteran's Crisis Line. Dial 988, then press 1.
