- September was back to school and the first official Month of providing contractual police services to the school district and it couldn't have started off any better. We have enjoyed being entrenched with our students, parents, faculty and community as we have provided a strong visual presence of authentic engagement. We have been able to do this by being at the school in the mornings, and afternoons while students are arriving at school wishing them a great day. We have also participated and been a presence at bus evacuation drills as well as a school district wide lockdown drill.
